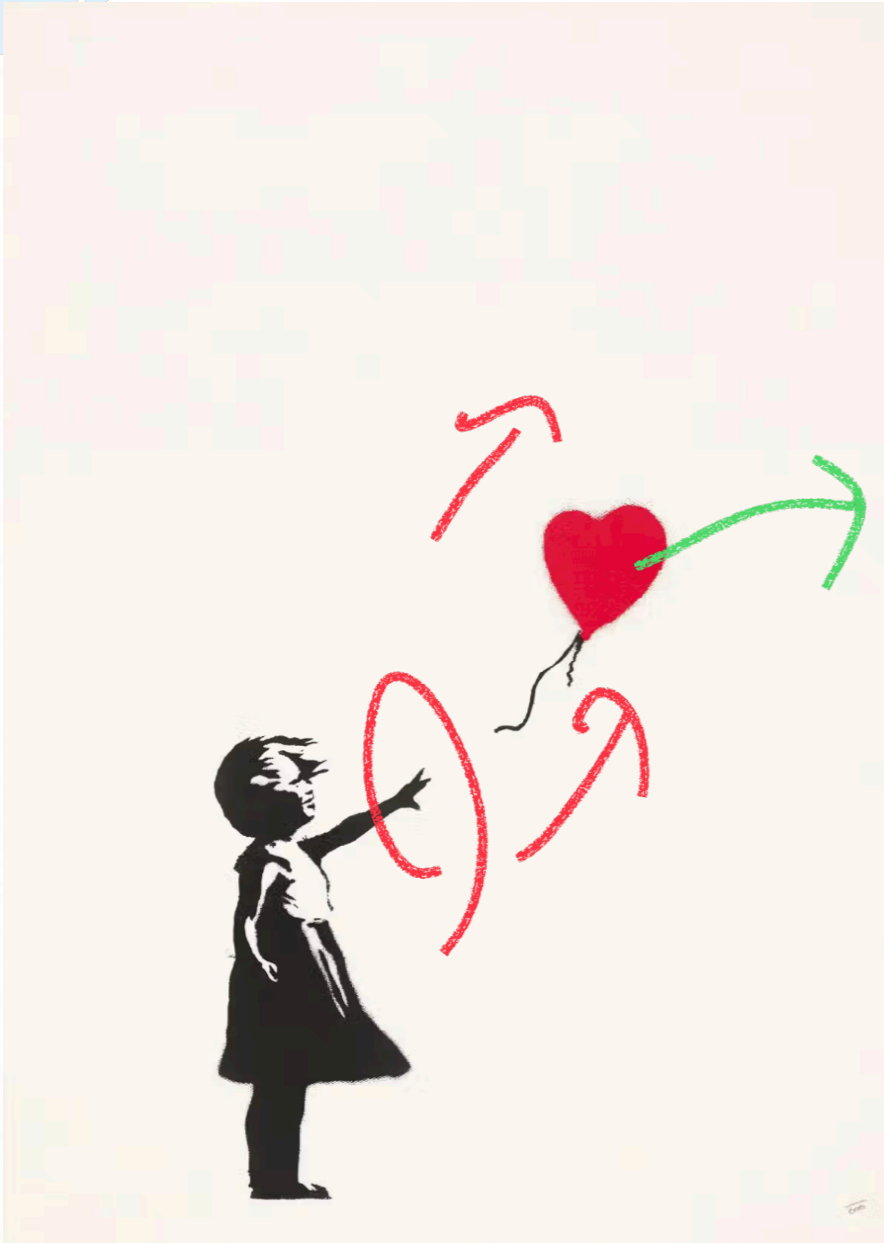

(Auction Price: \$1.4 million)

- One of Banksy's most iconic pieces, this artwork features a young girl reaching out for a red, heart-shaped balloon.

- In a 2013 stunt, Banksy set up a pop-up stall in Central Park, selling authentic, signed artworks for just \$60 each, a fraction of their actual value.
- Only a few people bought them, unaware of their true worth. Today, those who purchased pieces for \$60 own artworks worth tens of thousands, showcasing how perception influences value.

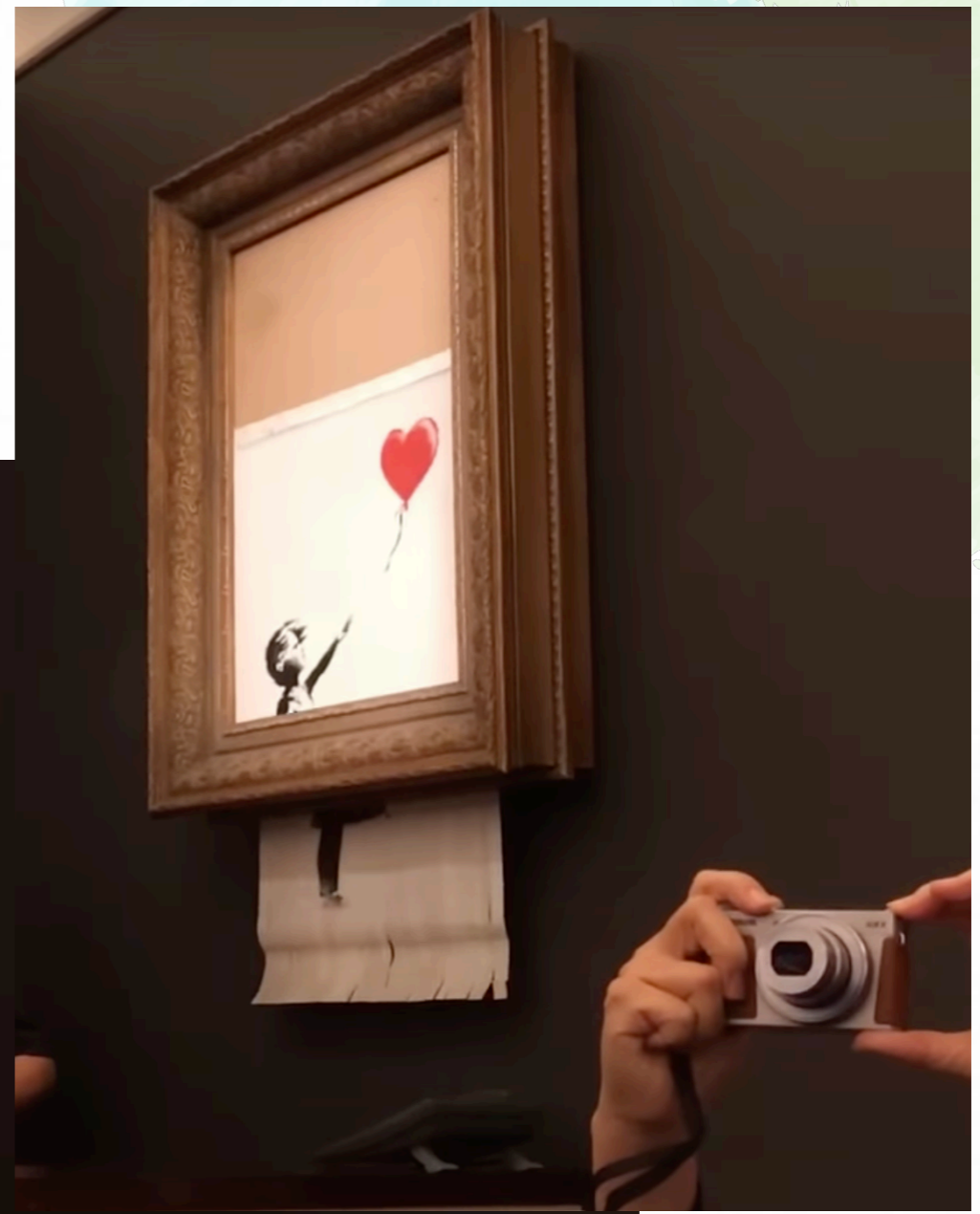
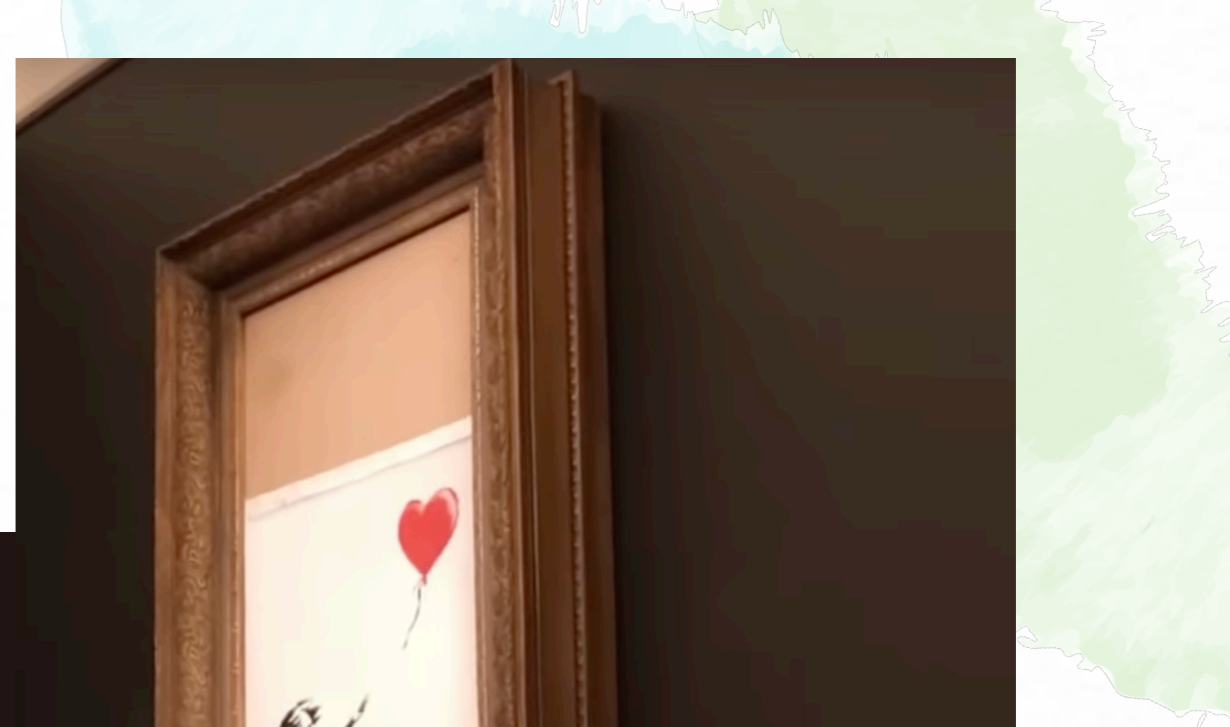
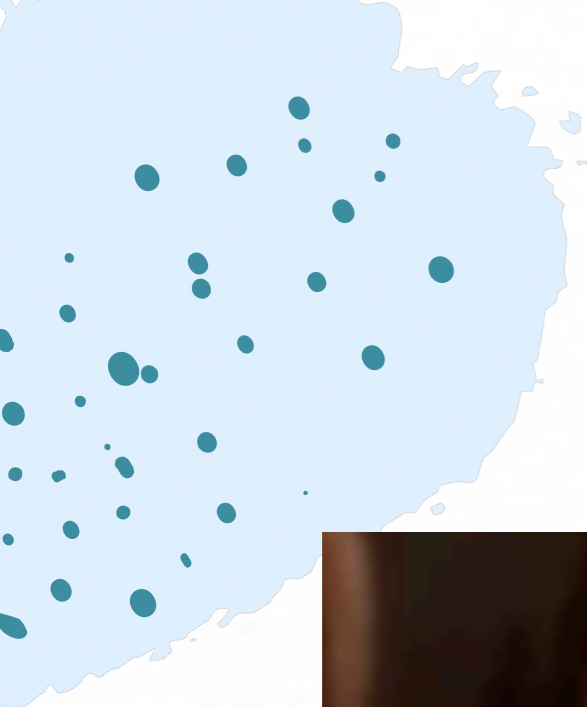

The Shredding of 'Girl with a Balloon'

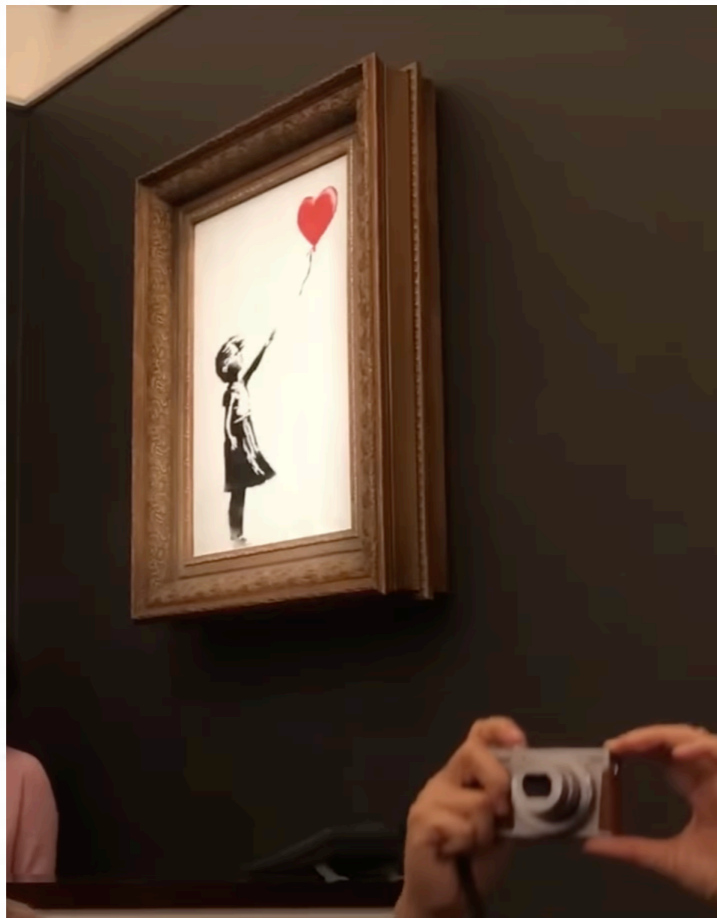
- In one of the most shocking moments in auction history, Banksy's 'Girl with a Balloon' self-destructed just seconds after selling for \$1.4 million.
- A hidden shredder inside the frame cut half of the canvas into strips, making it a new artwork called 'Love is in the Bin.' This stunt was a critique of the commodification of art and the absurdity of the art market.

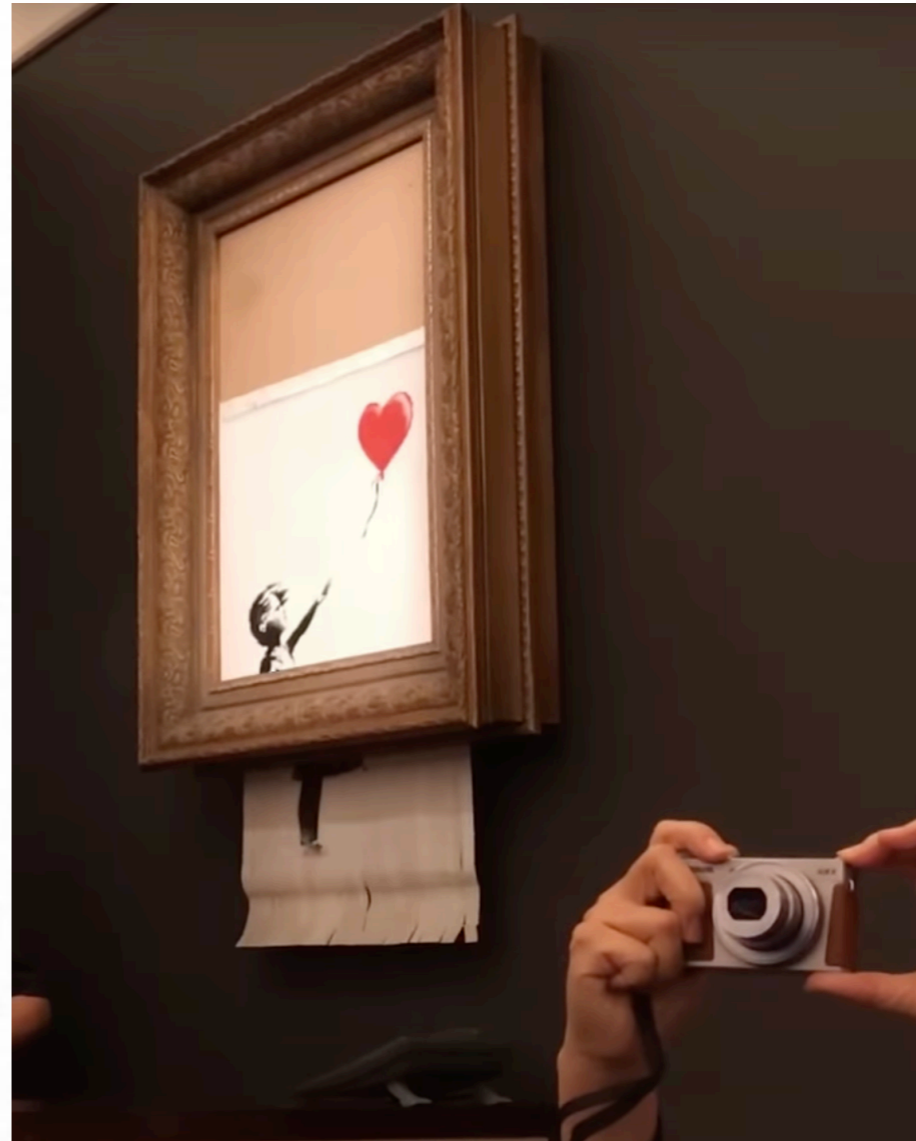
